

Parent/Student Information

The Shotgun team will practice at the Coon Creek Trap and Skeet Club located at 5393 Waltz Road Rio Oso. We will practice Trap periodically in the off-season and at least twice a week starting in January. The competitive trap season runs from March through July with 6 tournaments in various locations. Most locations are within the Sacramento area. The State Championships are located in Stockton and will be held in June 2023. The State Championship is a 2-day shoot on a Saturday and Sunday and is usually the 2nd weekend in June. The championship requires 200 shells or 8 boxes of shells. There is a US Open held in Las Vegas each year in July and is normally the 2nd weekend in July. It is a 5-day shoot running Wednesday through Saturday and is a National Championship. Skeet runs concurrent with the trap season and the US Open in July is for Trap, Skeet and Sporting Clays.

We also have a Sporting Clays Team made up of Team members who compete in the Fall. We start practices in September and have 5-series shoots through October and November and a State Championships the 2nd weekend in November. Our skeet team is made up of Shotgun team members and the competitive season runs concurrent with Trap. There are 4-series shoots and a state Championship in May. And Nationals in Las Vegas in July is for all 3 venues of trap, Skeet and Sporting Clays. We have Olympic Bunker in the Winter however this is a sport for someone who has a season or 2 of one of the other venues of clay shooting. Olympic Bunker is very challenging and for those pursuing the Olympics.

Needed for each shooter are a shotgun, ear protection, eye protection and an ammo pouch. Ear protection can be anything from muffs to the foam earplugs. Most shotguns used in trap are 12 gauge, but any gauge will work. Most field guns will work, and it does not matter whether the gun is an auto loader, pump or a break open action. In Trap, one shot is fired at a time. The ammo used are target/trap loads which use size 7.5's, 8's, & 9's shot. No hunting loads or other types of ammo can be used on a range.

The trap tournaments each have a \$50 entry fee paid by the team with team fundraiser dollars and require 100 shells or 4 boxes of shells. The price per box at the club is \$8.50 a box or you can buy them at SOS in a box of 100 shells for about \$35. Or you can buy them at the range for \$8.50 per box including the tax. At the practices, we like the shooters to shoot 2 rounds of 25 which would require 2 boxes of shells and we provide 1 box of shells with team fundraiser dollars. We get the club price of \$8 per round of 25 for the clays and we use our fundraiser dollars to pay for practices. Therefore, a practice would cost \$8.50. You pay as you go. There is also a \$35 registration fee for the CY SSA. We receive the NRA grant each year which helps pay for much of the practices and ammo for the shoots once the competitive season starts. We also have an annual fundraising dinner which generates a significant amount of revenue to offset the costs above for the parents. The only thing you pay for is 1/2 of the ammunition needed.

I encourage and appreciate parent involvement. A parent is required to be at the Safety Training required for each shooter before they can shoot. There will also be make-up safety training sessions when needed. Release and waivers, and medical consent forms must be signed by a parent or guardian before a shooter can participate. Shooters will need transportation to the range for the practices and to the tournaments. Carpooling works well.

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Parents/Guardians & Athletes - Please Read Carefully

In exchange for and as a condition of being allowed to participate in the California Youth Shooting Sports Association (hereafter "CYSSA") clay target program, Athlete and Athlete's parent or legal guardian, if Athlete is a minor child(ren), (hereafter referred to as the "Party" or "Parties"), agree to the following:

1. The Parties acknowledge that the CYSSA clay target program is a team-based program that provides team and individual competitions in the clay target sports which involve the use of firearms. Failure of Parties to adhere to safe handling and use of firearms at all venues and locations may be grounds for removal from the CYSSA program.
2. The Parties request to participate knowing and understanding that there are risks and dangers associated with the use of firearms, including property damage, serious bodily injury, and death. The Parties agree to assume all risks, inherent or otherwise, that may occur due to, arise out of or be in connection with the Parties participation, including without limitation the risk of property damage, serious bodily injury, and death. The Parties further agree to assume all risks, inherent or otherwise, that may occur due to, arise out of or be in connection with the participation of others in the CYSSA program, including without limitation, other competitors; instructors/coaches; staff or volunteers of involved organizations and individuals. The Parties acknowledge and agree that it is not possible to list all of the risks that the Parties may encounter by participating in the CYSSA program. There may be risks that are not known to the Parties, or to others involved in the CYSSA program, including staff or volunteers of involved organizations, and may not be foreseen or reasonably foreseeable by anyone at this time or at the time of the activities in which Parties participate.
3. The Parties agree to assume all known and unknown risks that may result in property damage, bodily injury, or death and all other risks in connection with Parties participation in the CYSSA program, whether or not described to the Parties. The Parties understand and acknowledge that there are risks and dangers associated with the use of firearms, firearm ammunition, mechanical devices and machinery associated with clay target shooting, and clay target shooting facilities that may result in property damage, bodily injury, or death.
4. To the fullest extent allowed by law, the Parties agree to defend, indemnify and hold harmless CYSSA and all involved/affiliated organizations and individuals, and each of their respective directors, officers, employees, agents or volunteers, from and against any and all claims, demands, actions, suits, proceedings, liabilities, damages, losses, judgments and expenses (including reasonable attorney's fees and costs) by third parties (including Parties family, heirs, or next of kin) for any bodily injury, death or property damage or other incident occurring due to, arising out of, or in connection with Parties participation or conduct, negligent or otherwise, in CYSSA.
5. Parties grant CYSSA and involved/affiliated organizations and individuals a royalty-free license to reproduce, publish, distribute, sell, or otherwise use in any reasonable manner, Parties name, photograph, likeness and statements in connection with the promotion of the CYSSA program, including, without limitation, the Internet, news articles, advertisements or other electronic or print materials.
6. Parties signature(s) below indicate that Parties have read and fully understand this entire Consent & Waiver, and that it shall be binding upon the Parties, their agents, heirs, assigns and next of kin.
7. Parties acknowledge and agree that, if Party breaches any provision of this Consent and Waiver, CYSSA would be irreparably harmed, that monetary damages alone may not be sufficient to adequately protect CYSSA from or compensate for such breach, and that, in addition to any other remedy, CYSSA shall be entitled to recover all expenses incurred in enforcing these provisions, including, but not limited to, attorneys' fees and expenses and court costs, and to a preliminary and permanent injunction enjoining such breach.

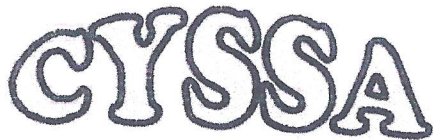

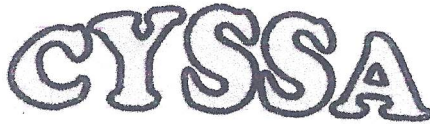
