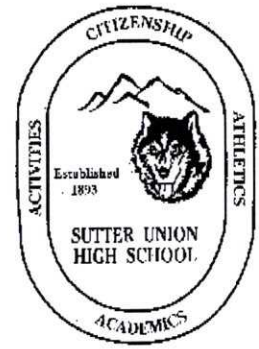

Dear Parents,

The first progress grading period of the school year ended on Friday, September 14th. We provide a mid-quarter grading period to serve as an early warning signal for students and parents. Progress grade reports will be mailed by Friday, September 21st. Your son or daughter's teachers will have grades posted on-line if you do not want to wait for postal delivery. If your son or daughter is not performing as well as you would like, please contact their teacher so that corrective action may be taken to improve academic performance before the quarter ends on October 12th. Early intervention is the key to success.

Blue Slips - Verification of Absence

Prior to taking your student out of school for an outside appointment (doctor/dental, court appearances, special permission, etc.), please send a note so your student may obtain a Blue Slip—leave of grounds. Absences due to outside appointments must be verified. **This verification can be done simply by having the doctor/dentist office staff, clerk of the court, etc., stamp, date and sign the Blue Slip or appointment card.** Student's must sign out through the office prior to leaving school.

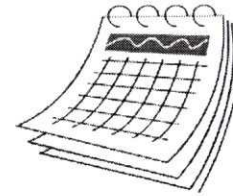
