SPEAKERS CONTEST

The Sutter County Board of Supervisors is hosting the “Public Business From The Floor” high school student speakers contest, which will be held on May 6. Designed to acquaint students with exercise of petitioning their local government, the contest provides speakers 3 minutes to address a topic under the jurisdiction of the county such as public health, homelessness, or land use. Participants must ask the Board of Supervisors to take a specific action on a topic, such as adding, changing, or removing a local ordinance, authorizing funding for something, or advocating for action by the state or federal government.
