 - Scan the QR code to view the current list of NCAA approved courses that we offer at Sutter High School.



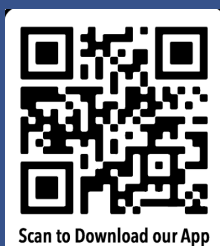
- **NAIA:** If you are planning to attend and play sports at a NAIA university, you will need to create an account through the [NAIA portal](#).

CAREER TECHNICAL EDUCATION (CTE)



- **Major Clarity/HopeSt:** All SUHS students are continuously utilizing Major Clarity and HopeSt, the newly adopted online career and college readiness platforms.
- Last month in MajorClarity, all students worked on completing their portfolio tasks and resumes as well as beginning their cover letters. Seniors also completed their Job Shadow requirement.
- This month for CTE: All students should be at 100% completion in their portfolios. Seniors that have completed a CTE pathway will receive a CTE certificate of completion and a cord to wear at graduation.
