- Consistently earn excellent grades ;take college preparatory curriculum that stresses English, Math and Science
- Plan on taking the ACT and SAT tests as early as possible and more than once
- Take part in activities and seek out leadership roles
- Become physically fit and participate in sports

BEGINNING IN YOUR JUNIOR YEAR

- Seek nominations to your academy of choice from your congressional representatives. Children of active or retired service men or women may also seek presidential nominations.
- Pass the Department of Defense Qualifying Medical Examination
- Score above average on the ACTs (plus writing section) and or/SATs
- Apply to attend a Summer Leaders Experience
- Continue to earn above average grades
- Pass the physical exam (candidate fitness assessment)
