- 01/19/2024: Last day to get HS Recommendation form signed for Spring 2024 Yuba College courses

YUBA COLLEGE/DUAL ENROLLMENT

- Send unofficial transcripts proving completion of Fall 2023 courses to Mrs.
- Spring enrollment for college courses is now OPEN! Scan the QR code to view the current Spring 2024 course offerings.



- To take Yuba College courses in Spring 2024 you must:
 - a. Submit an online Yuba College Application for Spring 2024.
 - b. Fill out and complete a <u>HS Recommendation form</u>. Once filled out, you need to meet with your counselor to discuss college course options. Following this, bring this form to Mrs. Collazo for authorization. The HS Recommendation form then needs to be turned in to the Yuba College Admissions office.
 - c. Register for classes online through YC self-service. The registration date for dual enrollment students begins on: 12/04/23; once courses are approved by YC Admissions.
- Last day to get a HS Recommendation form signed for the Spring 2024 semester from Mrs. Collazo is: Friday, 01/19/2024 @ 3:30PM
