Scholarships are awarded to as many students as there are funds available during the spring of each year. The minimum award is \$1,000 and the Scholar of the Year in 2023 will receive the top award of \$10,000. Payments to the recipients are made upon proof of registration in an accredited college or university.

The Foundation directors select a committee to review the applications and personally interview the finalists. In selecting Award Recipients, academic achievement, leadership potential and extracurricular activities, as well as financial need, will be taken into consideration.

Scholarships are awarded on a non-discriminatory basis, and they are open only to graduates of Sutter County High Schools.
